

## **SEED Youth Program Manager**

Are you enthusiastic and organized with experience managing educational experiences for young people?

The Summer Exploratory Experience in Design (SEED) program introduces youth to the field of design through a six-week collaborative project. Each week the students meet with design experts to receive guidance on their project, and visit relevant sites and organizations around the city. <u>The Sasaki Foundation is seeking an individual to coordinate SEED</u> <u>program logistics and oversee interns</u> in partnership with teaching assistants, design mentors, and partner organizations. This individual must work effectively both independently and in a team.

This position is expected to run between <u>June 5 and August 25, 2023</u>, with the option to continue part-time into the school year. The rate is \$25/hour. In this position, you would expect to work 37.5 hours per week, weekdays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. This is an in-person position based at 110 Chauncy Street in Boston.

## Administrative Tasks:

- Collecting and filing intern paperwork as required for grant reports and by law
- Reviewing and approving timesheets
- Scheduling and coordinating field trips and activities in a timely manner
- Preparing teams to participate in field trips
- Communicating with and preparing mentors for planned activities
- Communicating progress of teams and program with project manager

## Educational Tasks:

- Planning team-building activities
- Motivating and encouraging teams
- Participating with and engaging interns in field trips, site visits, and outdoor sketching activities
- Providing project and professional feedback to interns
- Dealing with disciplinary issues in a respectful and professional manner
- Communicating workplace expectations to interns

## **Requirements:**

- CPR certified or willingness to become certified
- Graduate student or college senior
- Minimum of 2 years supervising youth
- Experience coordinating field trips and/or hosting team-building activities
- Experience with or academic background in youth development
