If so, we would love for you to join us in the Designing Environmental & Social Impact internship to design your own independent project based in your community. You will learn to draw, to use design programs to visualize your ideas, and how to effectively communicate them. Through this experience you will also learn about social and environmental issues facing the communities in Boston and Greater Boston area.

At the Hideo Sasaki Foundation we partner with professionals in the design industry to mentor you through an independent project and to introduce you to the different careers you can pursue in design. From January to beginning of May you will work after school and on Saturdays for \$16.25/hour to design a solution to the issue you want to address.

- Grades 10, 11, and 12
- Resident of Boston, Belmont, Cambridge, Chelsea, Everett, Malden, Medford, Melrose, Revere, Somerville, Watertown
- Independent Learner
- Interested in exploring careers before graduating high school

- Applications open: October 1st
- Applications close: November 8th
- Interviews: November 21st & 22nd
- Final decision by: December 15th, 2024
