Our mission is equity in design. We fund community grants, host public events, and run youth employment programs. This empowers local communities, amplifies diverse voices, and engages students in career exploration.

RESEARCH & GRANTS

We convene experts and innovators from all backgrounds. We fund active research projects that center on inclusion and collaboration with communities who have historically been removed from the design process. Interdisciplinary design research builds more equitable cities and communities.

PUBLIC PROGRAMMING

We host events that amplify diverse voices and address socially relevant topics as we work toward systemic change. We engage civic leaders, educators, economists, technologists, and more to connect design and community-driven action. Informed and engaged residents are central ingredients of a successful community.

DESIGN EDUCATION

We run paid internships for youth to discover and explore careers in design, increasing diversity in the next generation of designers. We connect students and design professionals through deep and meaningful experiences. A thriving design industry employs a workforce that reflects the full community of lived experiences.

We are a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization founded in 2000 to honor Hideo Sasaki, a renowned landscape architect, trailblazing designer, and founder of the design firm Sasaki.

We envision a world where the built environment reflects the voices, values, and needs of diverse communities.
